Domica Hill is a proud Palawa woman from Lutruwita (Tasmania). From her studio on Gubbi Gubbi Country in the Sunshine Coast, Domica explores symbols and stories from past ancestors, to tell stories of the surrounding country she now lives on.

A Contemporary Aboriginal Artist who began painting more as a way of healing after the loss of her first luwutina (child), a little girl named Briar. Originally a secondary school teacher, she is now finding her path exploring symbols and stories from past ancestors. Domica's style is contemporary and vibrant combined with some traditional elements. She believes skin colour does not define us, but history, family, bloodline and experiences are what creates our identity.

This piece represents our ancestors that have passed depicted by the star symbols in the sky. They are shown in rays of light shining down on a path with different meeting spots along the way. It is a representation of your journey and how the ancestors are lighting the way and showing you where to go on your life journey.
